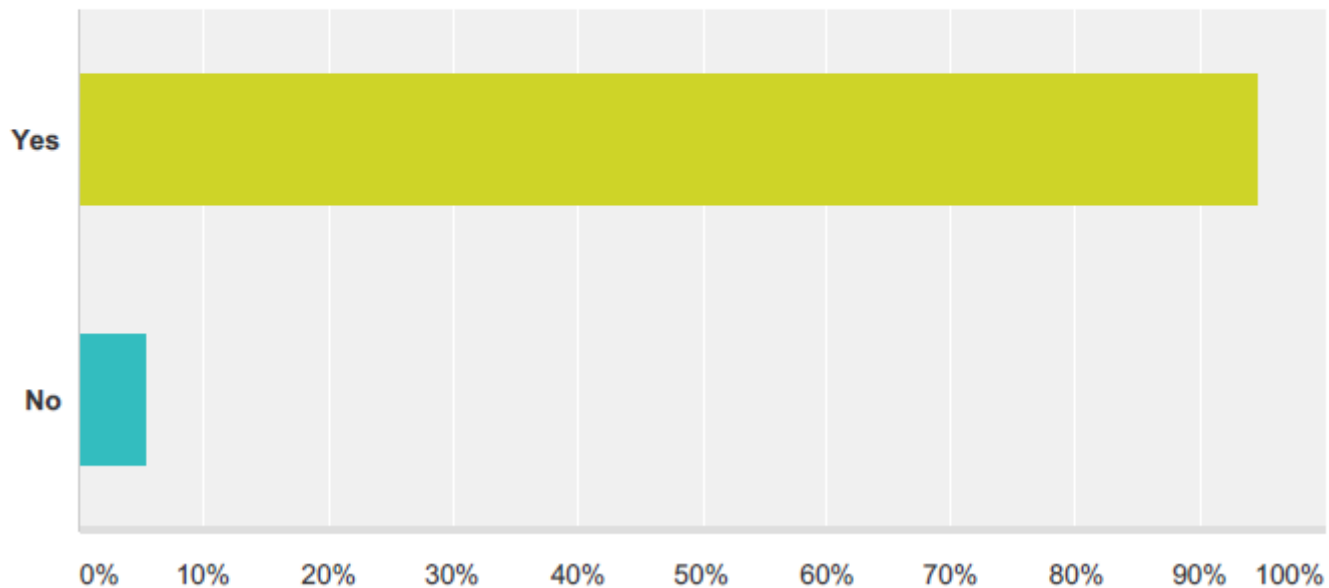

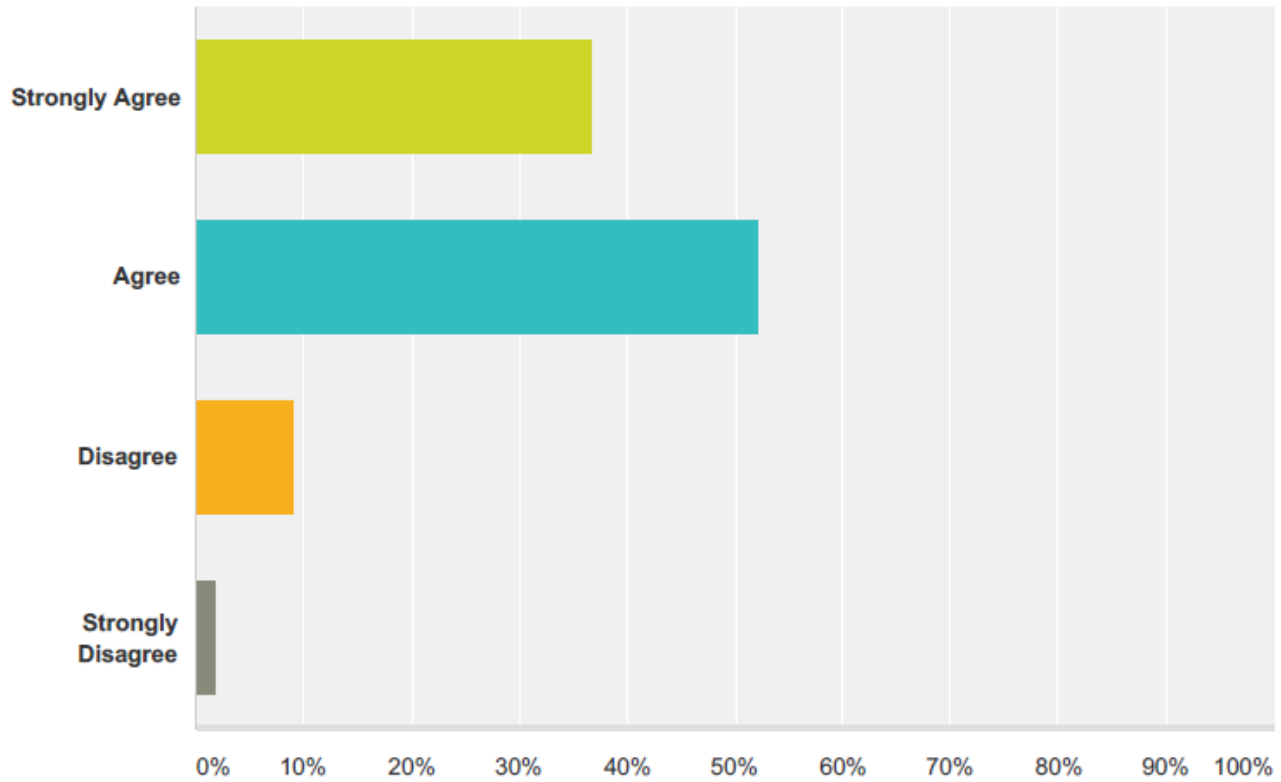

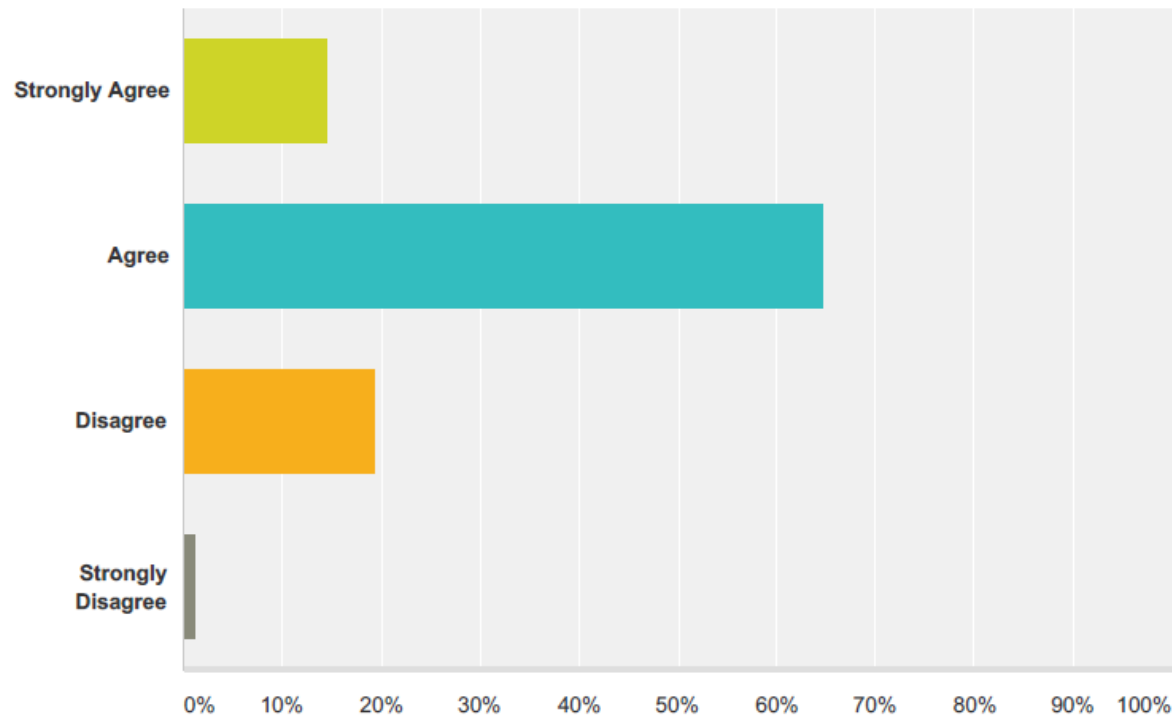

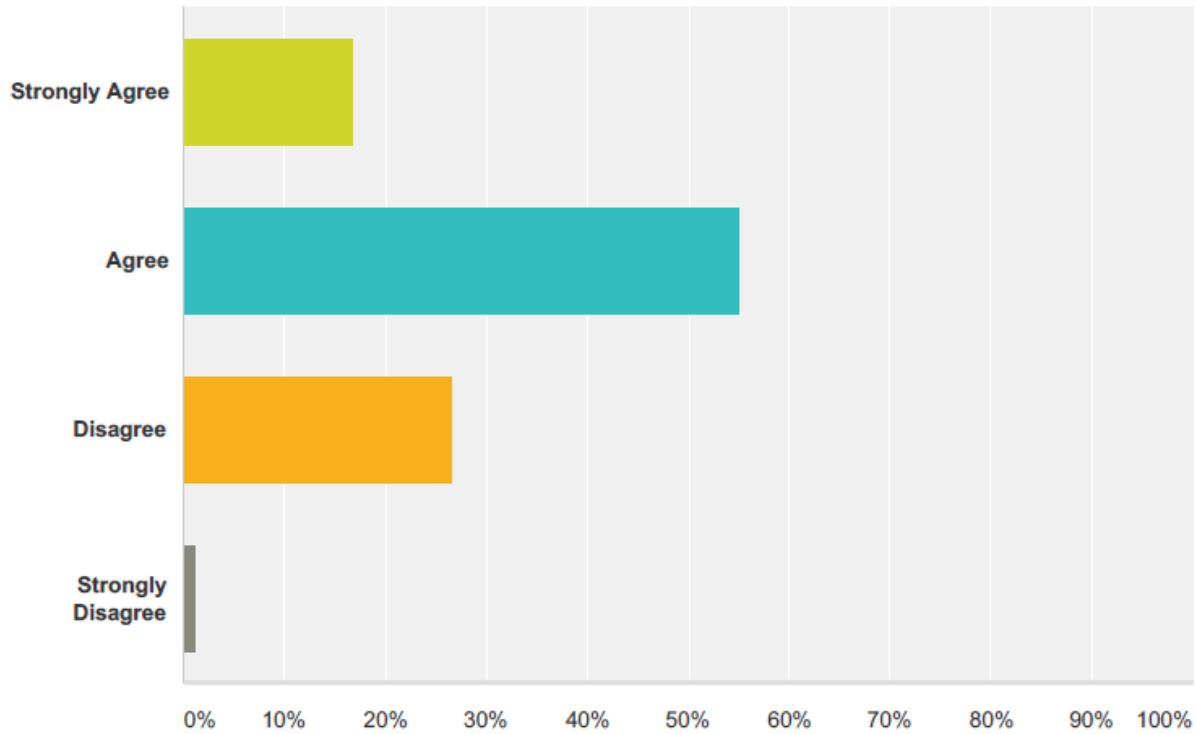

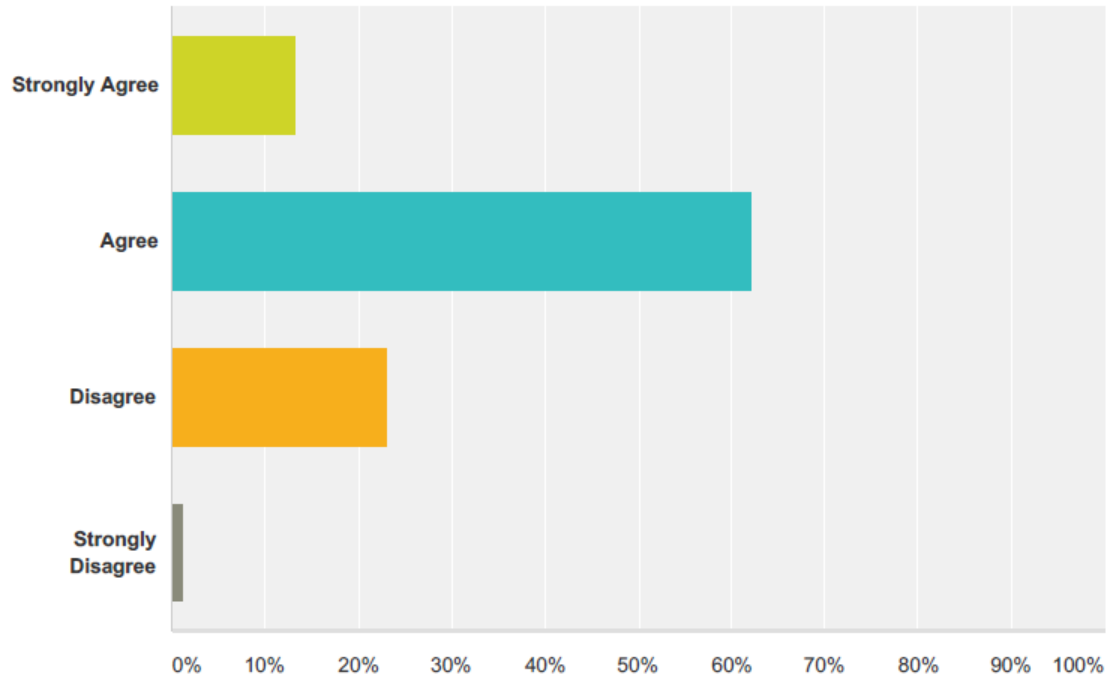

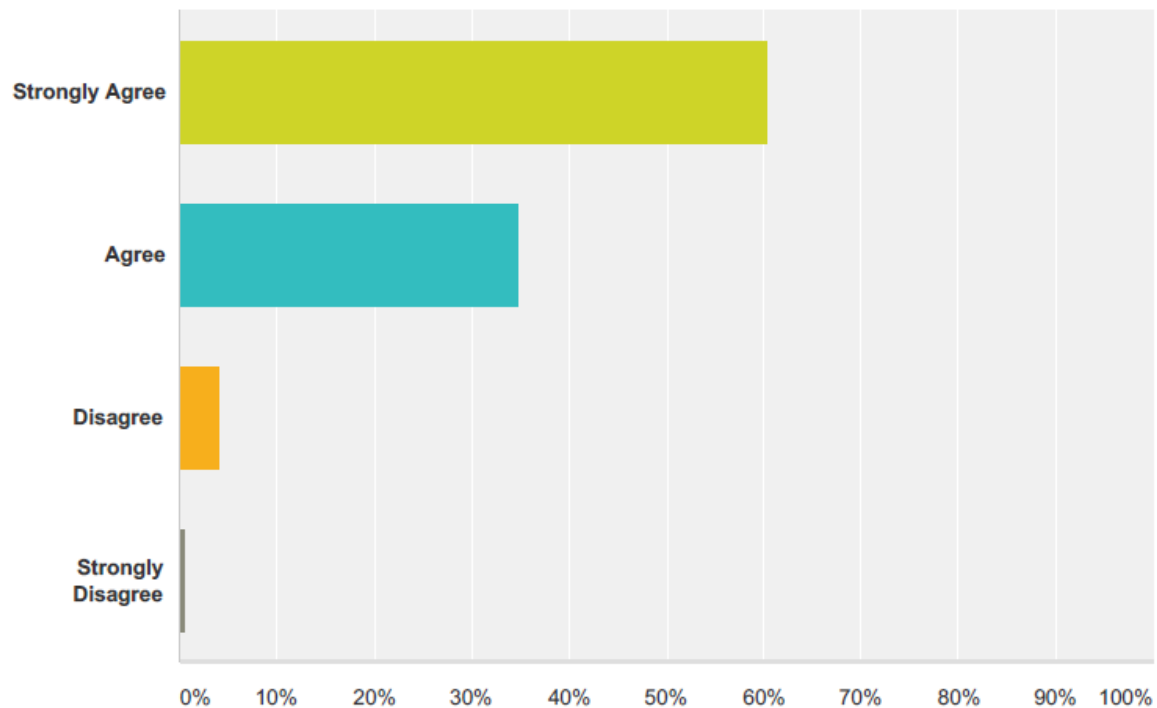

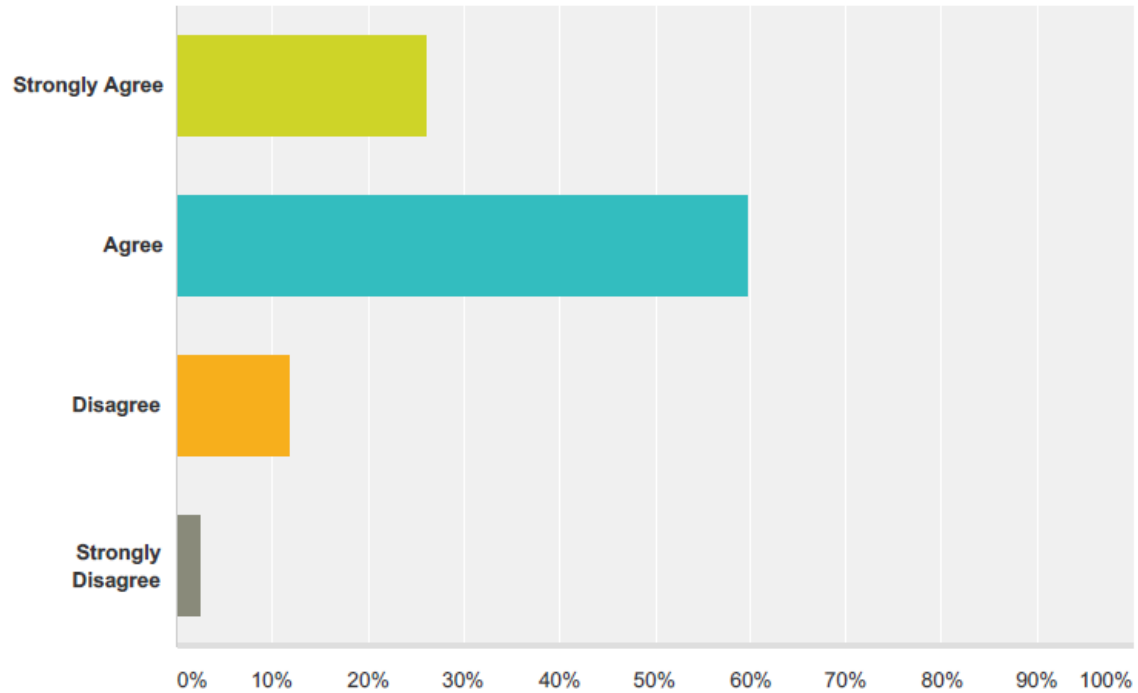

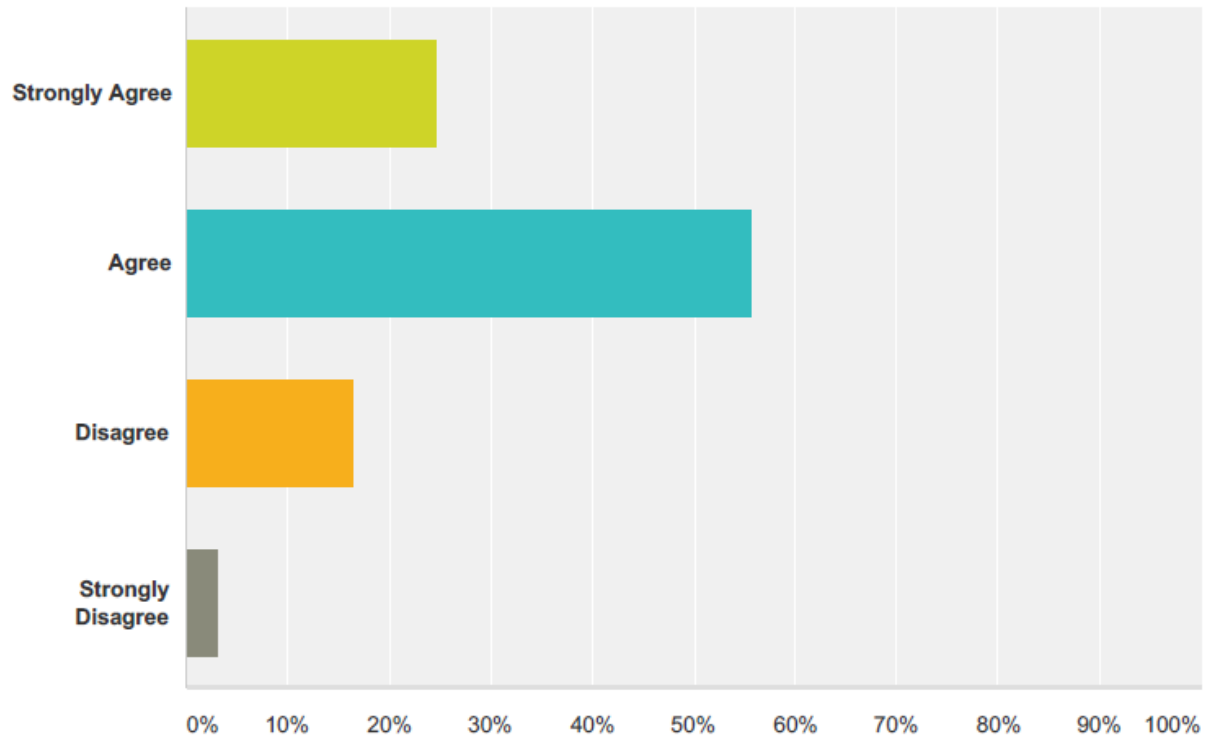

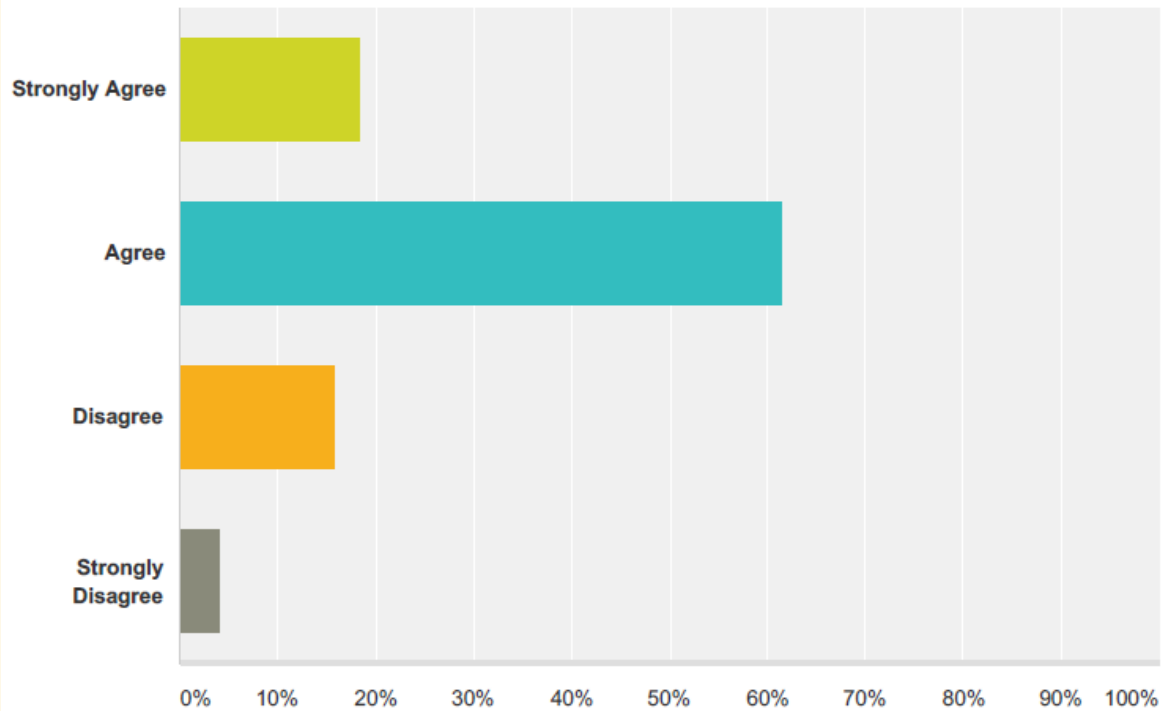

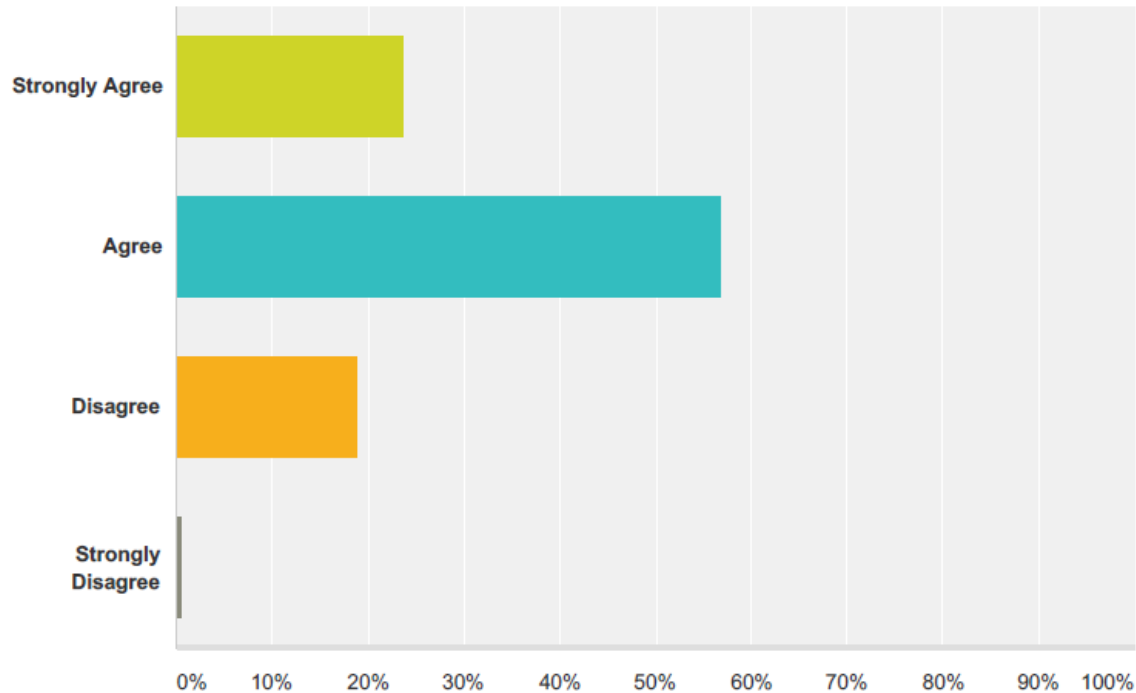

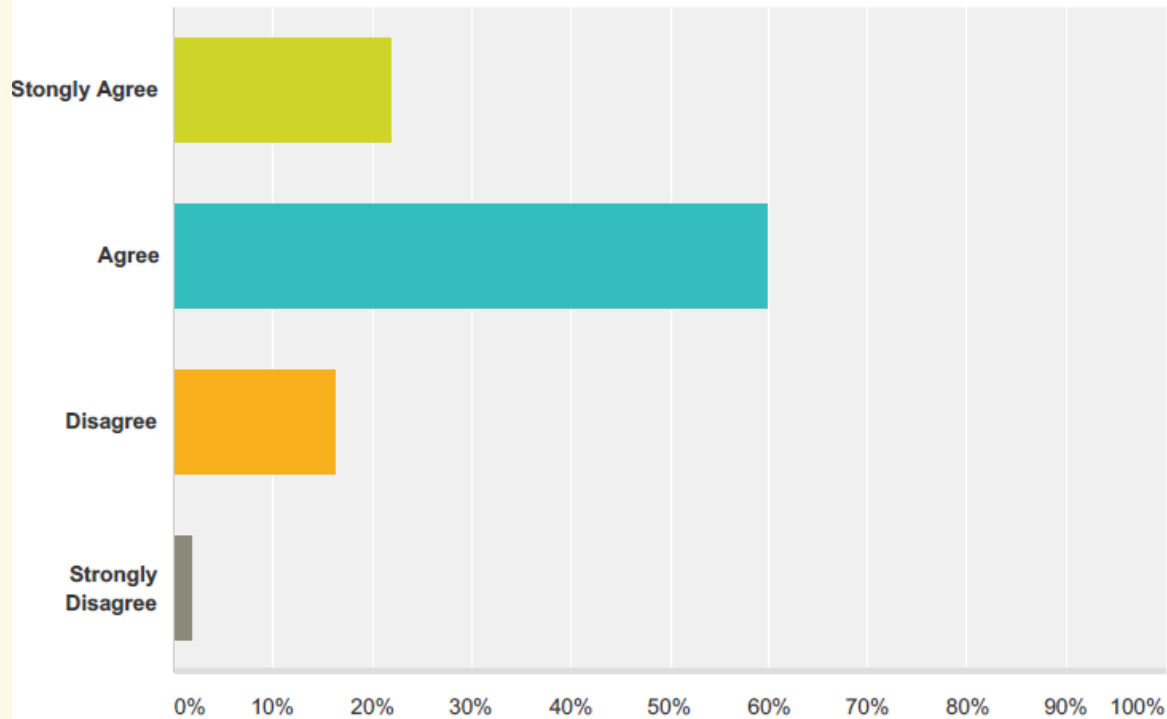

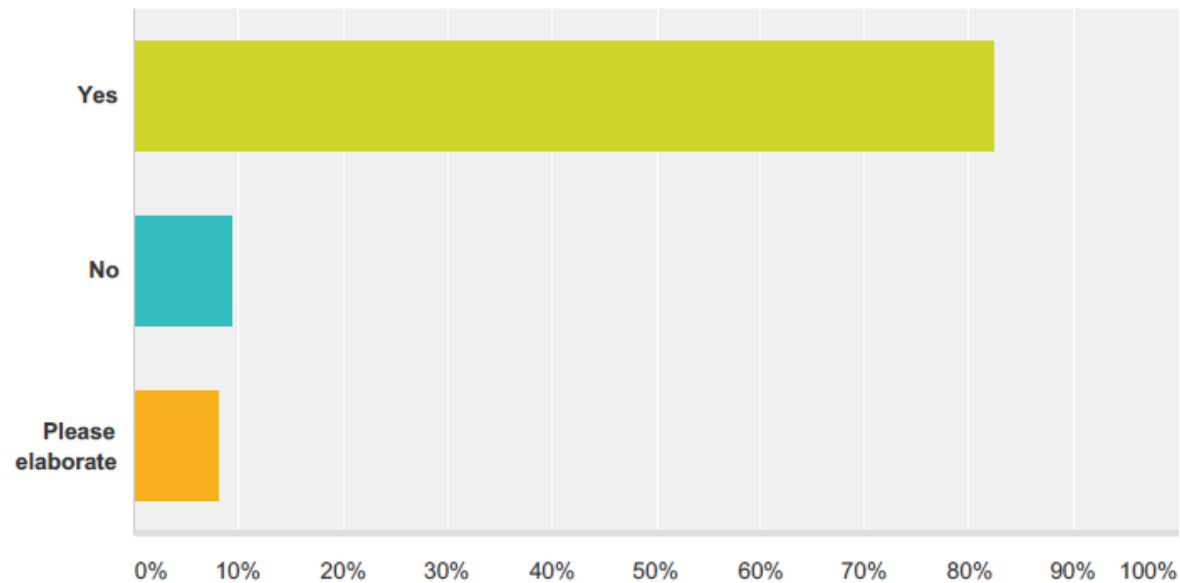

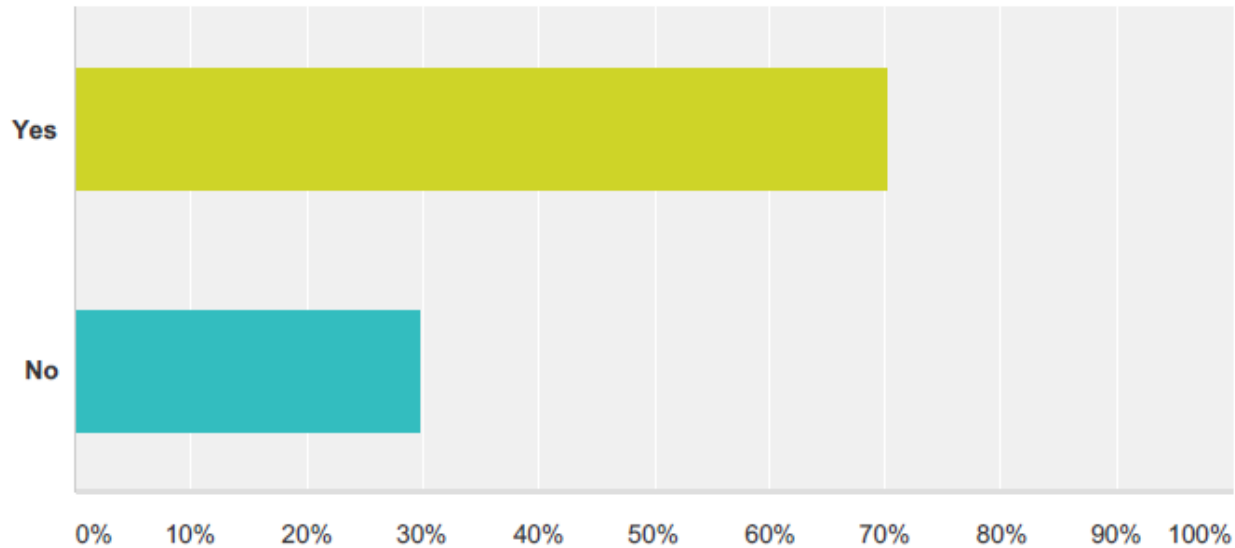

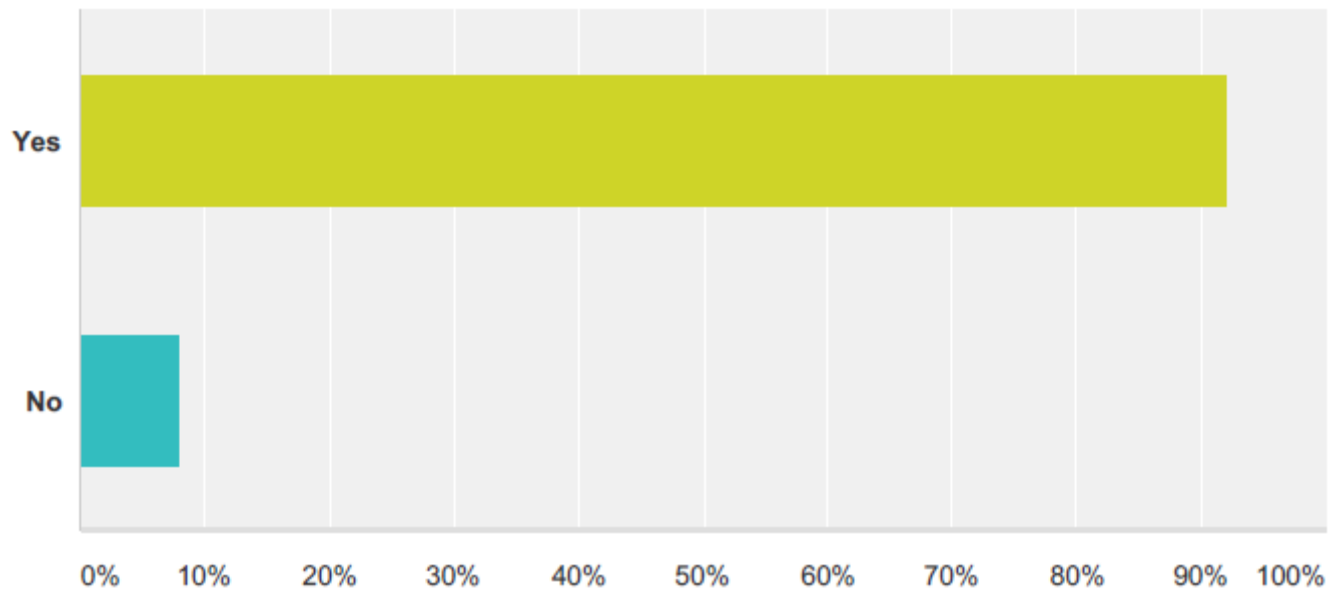

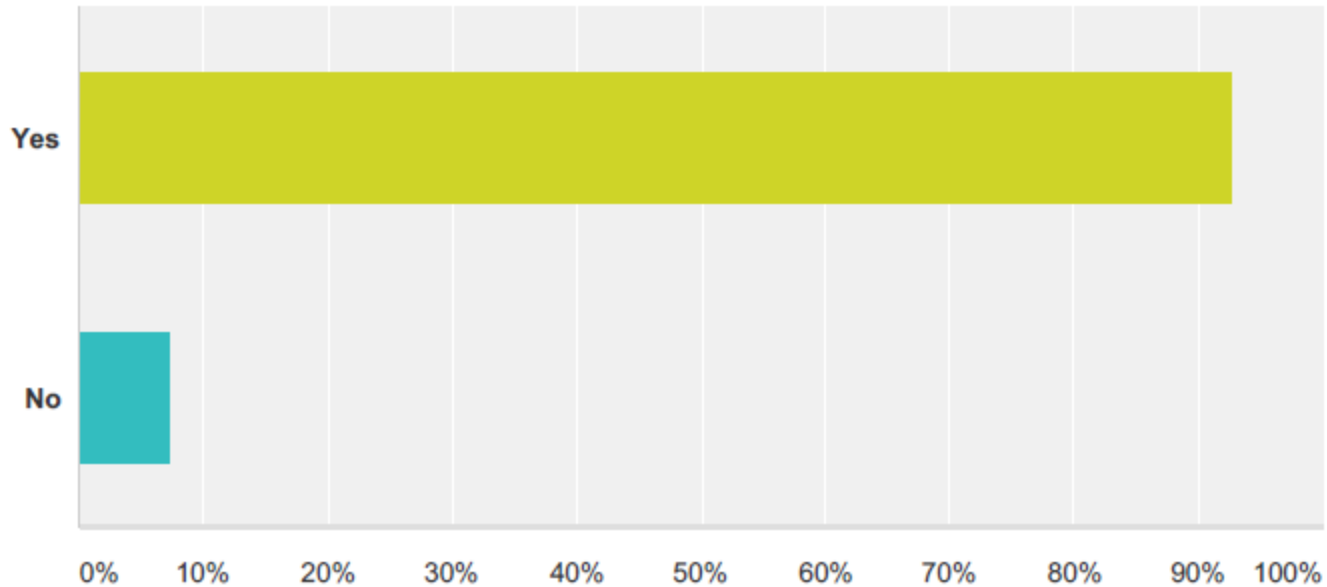

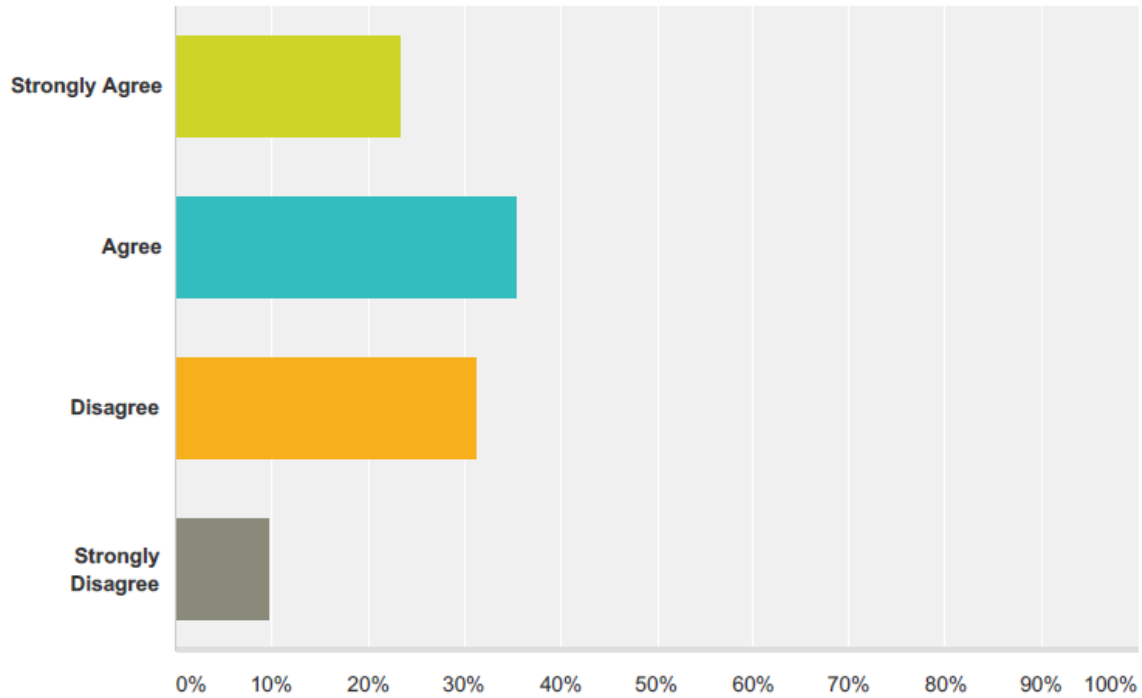

**Q17 I would move my child to another school in the district in order to access to a specialized program**

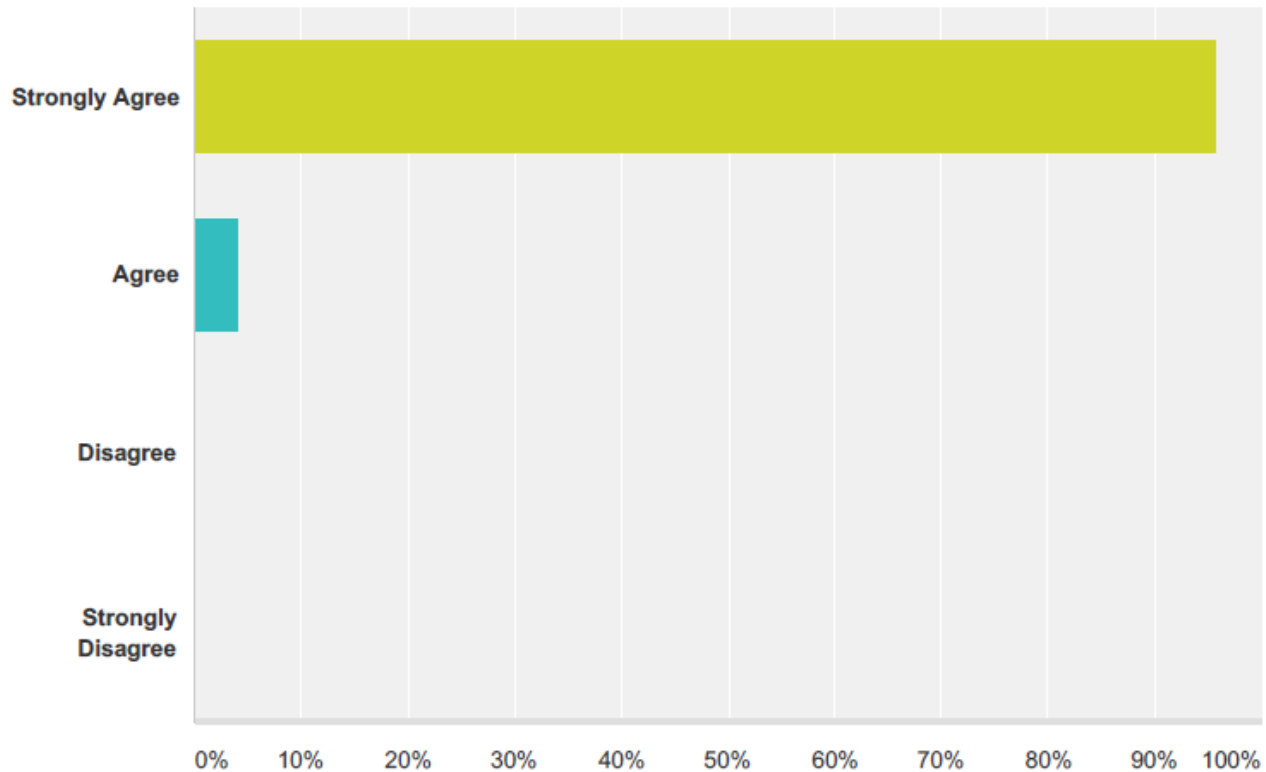
