**PRESENTATION** - The following was presented at the Regular Board meeting:

• **DOVER BAY** – Students from Dover Bay Secondary's art program had been commissioned to create art work that would be displayed at the District Administration Centre and the district's Boardroom. The students unveiled one of their tile pieces. Watch the presentation.



**NDSS PROPERTY** – Acting Superintendent Scott Saywell and Richard Harding, the City of Nanaimo's Director of Parks, Recreation and Environment, <u>presented</u> an update on the City's proposal to purchase the Rotary Bowl, Serauxmen Stadium, and a triangle parcel of land along with the joint construction plan for an artificial turf field behind NDSS.

The Board agreed to enter into a public engagement process where the public may provide feedback on the City's proposal. Input will be received until the end of the day Friday, March 10 via online survey, email, mail or at the open house.

- **AMENDED BUDGET** The Board adopted the amended budget bylaw for the 2016-17 fiscal year.
- FRANK J. NEY EXPANSION PROJECT
  - The Board directed staff to contract Low Hammond Rowe for the design and construction supervision for the addition to Frank J. Ney Elementary, subject to the successful negotiation of a client/architect agreement.
  - The Board directed staff to award a construction management agreement to Unitech Construction Management Inc., subject to the successful negotiation of a construction management agreement for the expansion project.
