**TEMPERATURES** – To help conserve energy during the winter break, daytime temperatures in Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools' (NLPS) buildings will be reduced. The temperature in every school will be lowered to the regular night time level – between 16 and 18 degrees Celsius for the entire two weeks, starting the evening of Friday, December 23. Thermostats will be back to normal when schools reopen Monday, January 9.

This is an important initiative in NLPS's quest to reduce its carbon footprint and become more environmentally friendly.

For schools that have the temperature indicated on a thermostat, if the temperature dips below 16 degrees Celsius, please contact Maintenance at 250-741-5242.
