Bowen Relief Run July 29 Brain Camp 2017 Retirement & Celebration Functions

RELIEF RUN – The Bowen Relief Run Committee hosts a fundraiser and awareness campaign for War Child Canada on Saturday, July 29 at Bowen Park. All proceeds from the event will go directly to War Child, with its current focus on the state of famine in South Sudan where there are 100,000 people at immediate risk of starvation; 50,000 of them children. War Child is working with qualified local personnel to ensure the best use of different types of aid is directed to the areas which need it most.
