TRUSTEES – On Wednesday, May 24, 2017, the Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools' Board of Education agreed to enter into a policy development notice of motion and two public consultations.

- To refer the matter of Trustee Remuneration to public consultation for an amendment to the current policy on Trustee Remuneration (Board Governance Policy 2.6 Meetings and Board Operations – Section 7.1.1) to read: "Trustee Remuneration is to be reviewed by the Board in September each year; such review is to be based on remuneration paid to trustees of comparable British Columbia School Districts."

Feedback and a report from district staff will be presented at the Business Committee Meeting in September 2017.
