SCHOOL SAFETY – Nanaimo RCMP is reminding drivers to slow down in school zones. A 30km/h speed limit is in effect in school zones from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on school days. Drivers should also keep in mind that excessive speeding in a school zone (**70 km/hr in a 30 km/hr zone**) may lead to their vehicle being impounded for seven days.

Tips to share with your students:

- Use designated crossing points and follow crossing signals where available
- Dress to be seen daylight hours are decreasing, so wear brighter colours or reflective material whenever possible
- Always be aware of your surroundings
- Leave ample time to get to school to avoid rushing and potential falls and mishaps
