REGISTRATION – The district recently launched its new online registration process. Superintendent John Blain explained that the new initiative is centralized and offers more flexibility for parents and guardians when registering their child for school.

Since the launch on January 11, 2017, the district has received over 700 new registrations for the 2017-18 school year. Included are approximately 550 Kindergarten, 200 French Immersion and 40 secondary school academy registrations.

The district is receiving early and late French Immersion registrations until January 31, 2017. Secondary school academy applicants have until March 31, 2017 to register.
