Recognize the Scam



External Emails

Look for the "Caution: External Message" tag at the top of every email.


Examples:

Check the Sender's Email Address


Check the sender's full email address to make sure it matches their official SD68 email address.





Asking for money, passwords, or sensitive information

Be especially cautious of any email requesting money, passwords, or other sensitive information.





Links and Attachments


Do not click on any links or open any attachments from unknown or suspicious sources





Use the Phone

Confirm details with the sender using another method (e.g. phone). Do NOT confirm details by replying to the suspicious email.
