

601.9AP - Malicious Damage and Theft

Purpose

Appropriate action shall be taken against any person breaking and entering, stealing, or wilfully or carelessly damaging Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools' property.

Procedure

- 1. Malicious damage, breaking and entry, or theft of Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools' property will be reported to the police as soon as possible.
- 2. Damages, breaking and entry, or theft of Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools' property shall be reported to the Facilities Department.
- 3. Damage or theft of consequence shall be reported to the Board.
- 4. Where any student wilfully or carelessly mutilates, destroys, or removes any school property, parents or guardians may be held liable under Section 115 of the *School Act* and immediate steps shall be taken by Administration to recover all costs.
- 5. In all cases going before the Courts, the Facilities Department shall prepare a statement of costs and shall make appropriate representation to the Courts for all costs incurred as the result of breaking and entering, theft or damage.
- 6. A notice to the effect that appropriate action shall be taken against any person breaking and entering, stealing and/or wilfully damaging school district property shall be placed and retained on the notice board in each school.
- 7. The Board may post a special reward for information that established the guilt of any person damaging, stealing, or breaking and entering property or buildings of Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools.
- 8. Sums of money shall not be left in a school overnight except in an approved safe.
