

AP 222 – Curriculum Advisory Body

Purpose

The Board of School Trustees endorses the formation of a consultative curriculum committee to be known as the Curriculum Advisory Body. The role of this body will be to make recommendations to the Board of School Trustees regarding locally developed courses, learning resources, reconsideration of learning materials and other matters which may be of interest or referred to it.

Procedure

- 1. The Curriculum Advisory Body will be comprised as follows:
 - a. Elementary Teacher (1)
 - b. Secondary Teacher (2)
 - c. Elementary Principal/Vice-Principal (1)
 - d. Secondary Principal/Vice-Principal (1)
 - e. Parents (2)
 - f. District Principal
 - g. Secondary Students (2)
 - h. Assistant Superintendent of Learning Services or designate
- Appointment to the Curriculum Advisory Body will be made after consultation with appropriate groups.
- 3. Appointment to this committee is for a one-year term. This appointment is renewable.
- 4. Members may be appointed to this committee to complete the term of a member who has resigned. This will provide committee continuity and rotation.
- 5. So that this committee may continue its deliberations without interruptions, members will continue to serve until a replacement and/or new committee is formed.
- 6. At its inaugural meeting each year the Curriculum Advisory Body will choose its chairperson.
- 7. The Curriculum Advisory Body will meet as required and determine its internal method of operation.
