

AP 301 – Student Attendance

Purpose

Students shall attend school on a regular basis and in accordance with the attendance procedures of the school and district.

Procedure

- 1. Students are expected to attend regular programs on a daily basis.
- 2. Students participating in a field trip, work experience or other such school sponsored activity during instructional hours shall be considered present for attendance purposes.
- 3. Students shall not leave the school during instructional hours without both permission of the school and knowledge of the parent(s) or guardian(s).
- 4. Students who are tardy or absent from school shall provide an explanation from their parent(s) or guardian(s) as to the reason for such tardiness or absence.
- 5. The principal or designate(s) shall accept as sufficient cause for student tardiness or absence from school:
 - 5.1 illness of the student;
 - 5.2 illness or affliction in the family;
 - 5.3 a danger to health or safety from serious exposure;
 - 5.4 an extraordinary circumstance or unavoidable cause which makes attendance impractical, if not possible.
