

AP 322 – Media in Schools

Purpose

The Board encourages schools to allow the use of all available media forms to record for the benefit of parents and the general public, the many worthwhile educational experiences that are developed in the district schools.

Principals shall use their discretion in allowing access to the schools by press, radio and T.V. personnel.

Principals should work with the Director of Communications if the media coverage has the potential to be controversial, or has district-wide implications. Principals are also encouraged to inform the Director of Communications if the coverage is of special note and would be of interest to trustees and other school district staff.
