SUBJECT: APPROVAL - Tender #2546 – John Barsby and Ladysmith Secondary Schools Dust

Collection System Upgrades

John Barsby and Ladysmith Secondary Schools Dust Collection System Upgrades was approved though 2020-2021 Capital Plan with funding through the School Enhancement Program (SEP) with a ministry approved combined budget of \$900,000.00.

On behalf of NLPS, Rocky Point Engineering Ltd. (RPE) issued "Invitation to Tender 2546 – "John Barsby (JBS) and Ladysmith Secondary School (LSS)- Dust Collection Upgrades", through a public tender process. A mandatory conference call was held on April 22, 2020 at 2 pm; with a tour of both sites on April 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. Multiple contractors attended, all of which signed in.

At tender closing on May 1, 2020 NLPS received three compliant bids on this project with a combined low bid of **\$899,000.00**; \$446,000 for JBS and \$453,000.00 for LSS.

Alternative pricing for pneumatic systems and the dust collectors were examined to lower the overall project costs; however any cost savings came at a price of less robust equipment, higher long term maintenance requirements, or excessive lead times, which would have affected the overall project schedule. It was decided to go with the base bids; and engineered specified items in the tender.

As total project costs exceed the ministry approved funding by \$154,761 the Facilities Department plan is to relocate funds from the 2020 Park Ave SEP funded project to cover the additional costs to complete both dust collectors.

The Facilities Department recommends that School District 68 award the contract for the Ladysmith Secondary Dust Collector and John Barsby Dust Collector to Universal Sheet Metal in the value of \$899,000 (plus GST); and approve \$1,054,761 to complete both projects.
