<b>Data storage location</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Canadian anonymous workstation accounts are linked to servers in the USA.</li><li>• Personal work is stored on local NLPS servers.</li></ul>
<b>Data review/retention</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students that leave NLPS will have accounts deleted in September of the following school year.</li><li>• Requests to cancel accounts may be done at any time by IT through the supervising classroom teacher.</li></ul>
