## **TOPICS:** Draft Transportation Administrative Procedure 2020 Vision: A Three Year Plan Animals in Schools Administrative Procedure

**TRANSPORTATION** – Following the Board's approval of Board Governance Policy 3.8 – Transportation at the November 23, 2016 Regular Board meeting, Superintendent John Blain and Assistant Superintendent Bob Esliger presented a <u>draft of Administrative</u> <u>Procedure 512 – Transportation</u>.

The committee recommends that the Board defer draft AP 512 – Transportation to the January 18, 2017 Business Committee meeting and that staff bring forward an outline with procedures governing safety.
