

# Google CSFirst

Google CS First is an online platform for creating, managing, and teaching the basics of computer science concepts to students in late elementary and middle school. Coding is done largely through MIT's excellent Scratch platform.

## Summary of the Privacy Assessment

- Google does not ask for any personally identifiable information from students through CS First.
- To preserve student privacy, names added to CS First accounts in the teacher dashboard are stored on the computer and browser rather than on Google's servers.
