Features of the New Teams Experience

New features include:

- Breakout Rooms create sub-meetings within your Teams meeting to allow for smaller group discussions
- Large Gallery Mode see up to 49 people on a screen
- Together Mode see meeting participants in theatre seating
- Pop Out Meetings view your video conference in its own separate window
- Meeting Notes take notes in the main Teams window (separate from the meeting window)
- Focus Mode view only the content that is being shared and not participant video feeds

How to Get the New Teams Experience

Run the Teams Updater that will update your version of Teams and make sure the new Teams Experience box is checked – that's it! (Detailed instructions below)

No problem – the version you're running now will continue to work minus the features listed above.


Updating Teams

When logged into a district computer at your work site, run the TeamsNME.exe. It will update Teams on your computer and close Teams as part of the process.


1. Open up File Explorer and go to the Public (X:) Drive



- 2. Double click on TeamsNME.exe in the root of Public (X:) to update Teams
- 3. When Teams is updated, you will see this Box. Click on OK to close it




4. In Teams, Click on your User Profile, and select Settings





5. In Settings, select General and the Box Turn on new meeting experience should be checked. If not, please check it.

If there is no check box for turning on the new meeting experience, move to step #6 below.



6. Not all versions of Teams will have the "Turn on new meeting experience..." check box. In this case, the only way to test for sure, is to try a test meeting.


7. Go to your calendar and select Meet Now to do a test meeting



8. Select Audio and you can join the meeting. You can also select the Video as well.




9. Select Join Now





10. Your Teams Meeting Control Taskbar toolbar should be at the top of the screen.
