

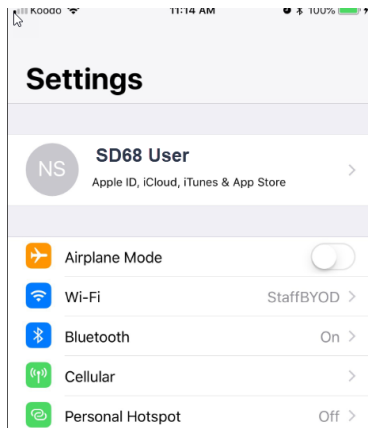

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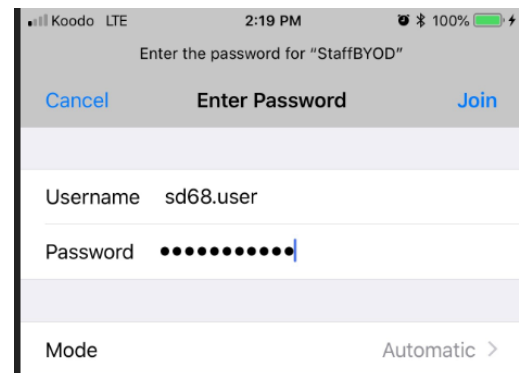
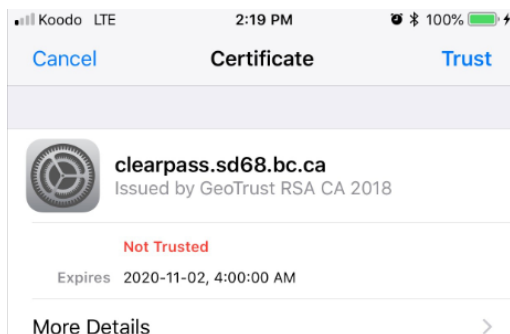
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Connect to StaffBYOD

1. Go to [Settings](#) on your iPhone
2. Under Wi-Fi select [StaffBYOD](#) for your network.

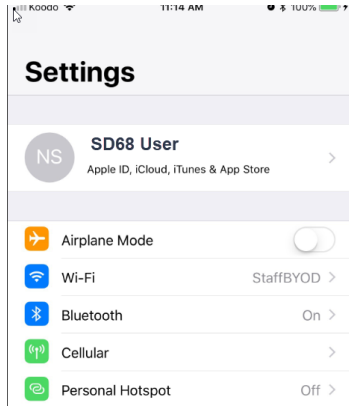



3. The password is your SD68 [username](#) and [password](#).
Select [Join](#)
4. Accept the certificate and select [Trust](#)

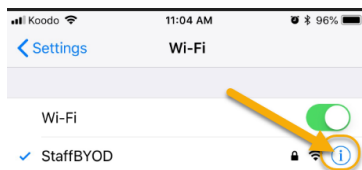


If you are connected and having problems or you have changed your SD68 password select [Forget](#) the StaffBYOD network and follow the steps to connect to it again.

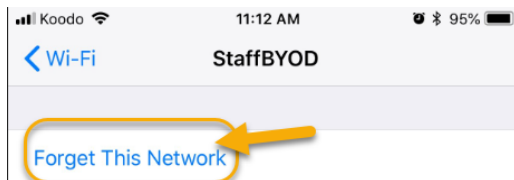
1. Go to [Settings](#) on your iPhone
2. Under Wi-Fi Select [StaffBYOD](#) for your network.



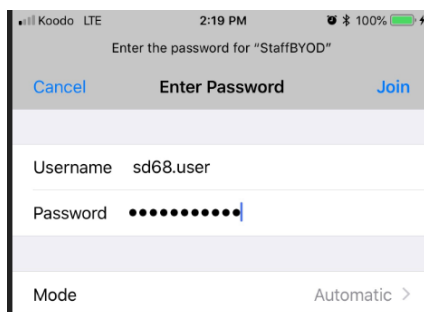

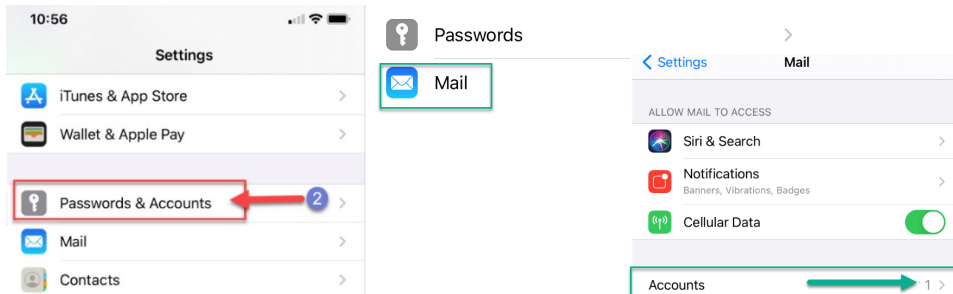


Select [StaffBYOD](#) again and enter your username and password.



Add an IOS Email Account

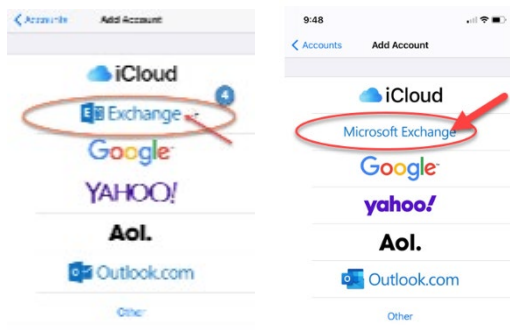
1. Go to [Settings](#)
2. Scroll down and Select [Passwords & Accounts](#) for older IOS or [Mail – Accounts](#) for IOS **14.1** and later



3. Select [Add Account](#)



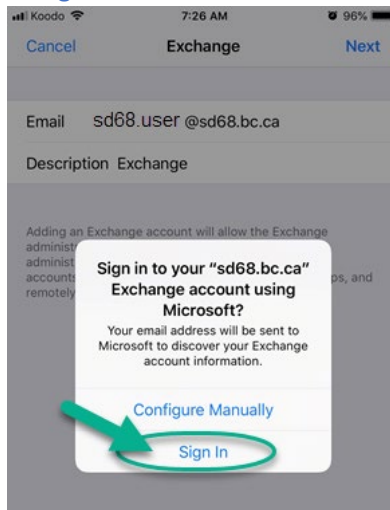
4. Select [Exchange](#) or [Microsoft Exchange](#) depending on what version of IOS you have



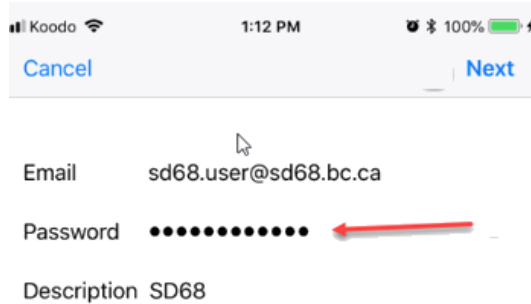
5. Enter your [email address](#), and [Description](#) of your account or accept the [default](#)



6. Select [Next](#)
7. Select [Sign In](#) and select [Next](#)

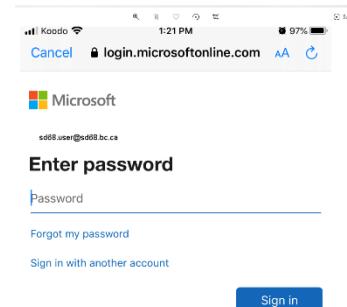


8. Enter your [password](#) You should see checkboxes on these 3 fields when your password is accepted.

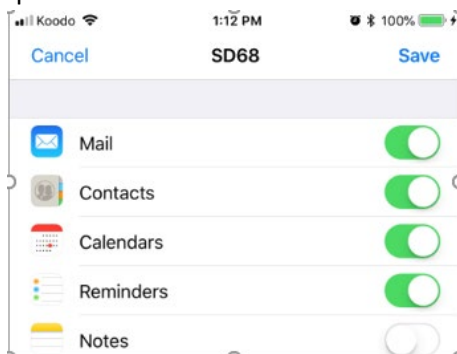


9. Select [Next](#)

Note: If your mailbox has been migrated to the Cloud, you will see this screen instead. Enter your [password](#).

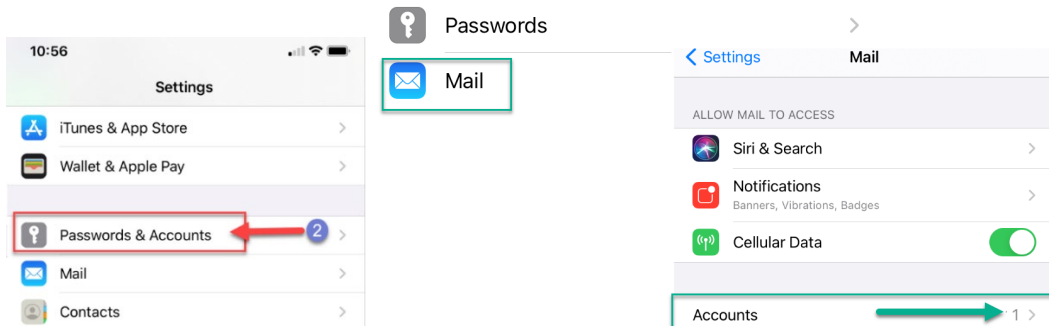


10. Accept the defaults in this screen and select [Save](#)



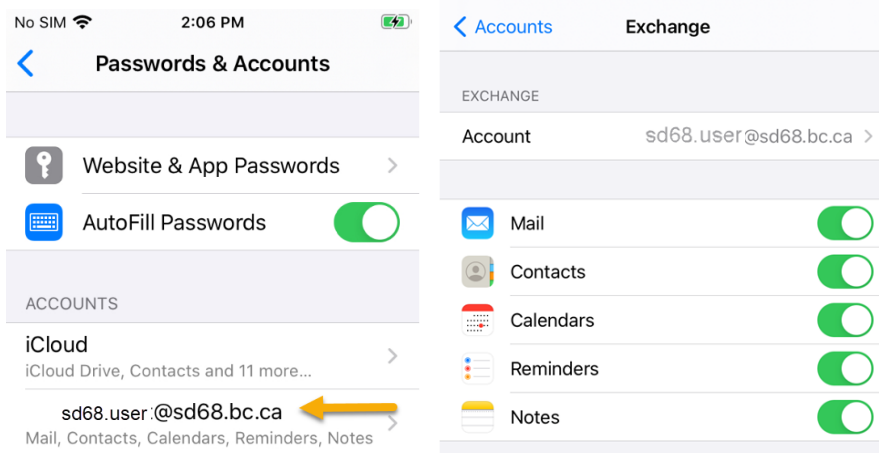
Change your Email password in IOS Email App

1. Scroll down and Select **Passwords & Accounts** for older IOS or **Mail – Accounts** for **IOS 14.1** and later

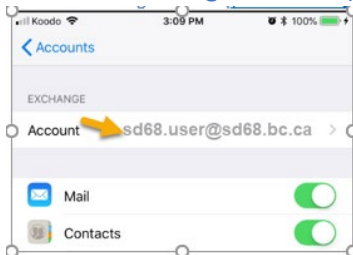


1. Select your **SD68 email account**

2. Select the **Exchange Account (yourusername@sd68.bc.ca)**



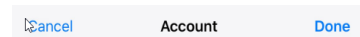
3. Under your Username it will say **Password**. Backspace the current password to get to the beginning and enter your new password

4. Select **Done**

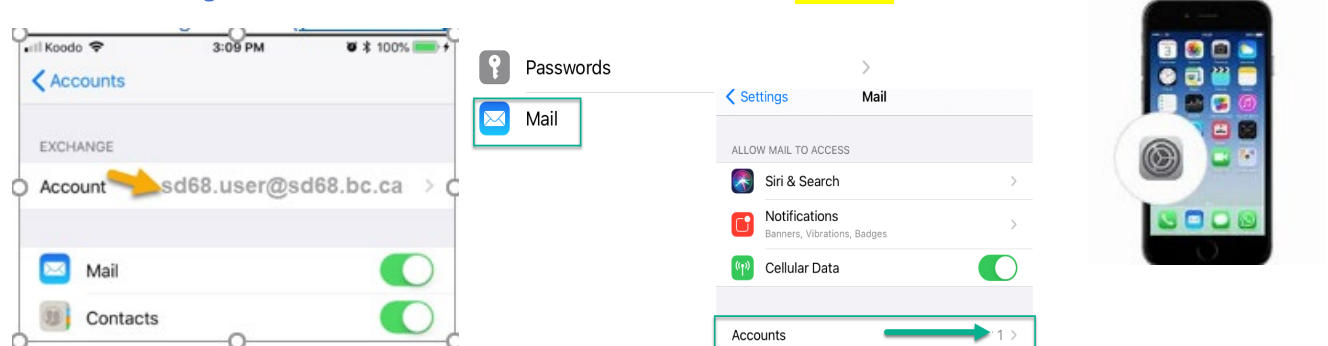

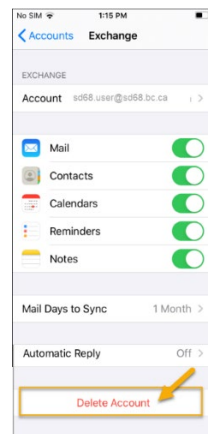
Remove your IOS Email Account

If your mail account stops syncing you may have to remove your email account and add it back again. If your email account has been migrated to the **Cloud**, you won't be able to change your password. You have to **remove** your email account and **add** it back again.

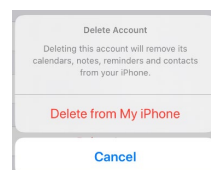
1. Go to **Settings** – **Passwords & Accounts** or **Mail- Accounts** for **IOS 14.1** and later



2. **Select** your email account
3. Scroll down to Delete Account and Select **Delete Account**



4. Select **Delete from My iPhone**



Follow the instructions to add your Email account again.
