Year End Report 2014/2015 Approved June 5, 2015 L4L Special Meeting

Context

Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools (NLPS) is currently on its 3rd Aboriginal Education Enhancement Agreement (AEEA). The AEEA is a signed partnership agreement between NLPS, the Ministry of Education and our five Aboriginal community partner groups. This partnership agreement is an important one, as it ensures our Aboriginal partners are just that, partners in our educational mandate. Our NLPS Aboriginal partner groups are comprised of representatives from the three land-based First Nations: Snuneymuxw, Stz'uminus, Snaw-Naw-As; Tillicum Lelum Aboriginal Friendship Centre; and Mid-Island Metis Nation and are called "Leaders for Learning" (L4L).

Over the school year L4L amended their Terms of Reference (*Attachment A*), developed the 2014/2015 strategic direction (*Attachment B*), participated in leadership development coaching (*Attachment C*), met with key district leaders, and hosted a cultural gathering for a new Board of Education (*Attachment D*), in addition to its regular monthly meetings. Results from the L4L Year End satisfaction survey (*Attachment E*) showed Leaders were once again 100% satisfied with their overall accomplishments this year.

L4L meeting participation was noted to be slightly lower over last year. Leaders acknowledged many changes occurring in communities' leadership and a demanding workload of education coordinators may have been contributing factors. The L4L Chair, Director of Instruction ensured strong communications between meetings, where a leader was unable to attend. Leaders also acknowledged great strides around the *Collective Ownership* concept built with the previous Board of Education. However, in the fall of 2014, a new Board of Education was sworn in and is comprised of nearly all new delegates. Leaders recognized a need to pause and allow time for this new Board to settle into their new roles. L4L look forward to continuing to build a strong sense of Collective Ownership with our new Board of Education.
