



NLPS Lacrosse Academy

Located at Nanaimo District Secondary School.

The Lacrosse Academy is an elite lacrosse program designed to develop individual and team skills. The program includes frequent travelling to tournaments within British Columbia, and International travel to the United States.

Open to Grades 8-12 students with previous lacrosse experience. Entry into program will be done by evaluations and application.

Intent of the program/academy

To improve both individual and team lacrosse specific skills.

Timeline (full-year or semester)

This is a full year program that includes both a Junior and a Senior program.

Travel or equipment requirements

This academy is highly competitive, and include frequent traveling to tournaments (including the United States). Cost for these tournaments are extra.

Fundraising expectations

Players are required to participate in fundraising events to supplement the additional costs associated with this academy.

Please Note: Transportation to and from the Academy is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian.

Applications must be completed and received by Central Registration by March 1/2020. Applications that are not fully completed will not be considered for entrance to the program.

Fees and breakdown

- ▶ **New Players** – New player fees are higher because they receive a helmet and gear bag.

Male \$1,200.00

Female \$600.00 * Fees are lower for female players because International tournaments typically disallow female players. The focus for female players will be on skill development with less focus on competing in tournaments.

- ▶ **Returning Players**

Male \$1000.00

Female \$500.00

The fee breakdown varies considerably from year to year. The fees help cover: equipment, apparel, transportation, prime fitness, facility rental and trained instructors.
