



NLPS Soccer Academy

Located at Nanaimo District Secondary School.

The NLPS Soccer Academy is a formal training program within the school day. A typical week includes one gym workout, three on-field sessions, and one classroom session, with a commitment to excellence in student achievement. The academy will NOT be playing in a formalized league.

New applicants will be expected to demonstrate their involvement in community soccer, commitment to high standards, and willingness to make a superior effort in the academy and their entire school program.

Intent of the program/academy

The intent of the program is individual development, not team development or success. Applicants must exhibit good standing in academics, attendance, participation, and conduct.

Timeline

Both classes run simultaneously (and train together) first semester.

Travel or equipment requirements

Players require their own cleats and shin pads. Academy athletic wear is supplied. Travel is minimal, players are usually only bused from Prime Fitness Centre.

No fundraising requirements.

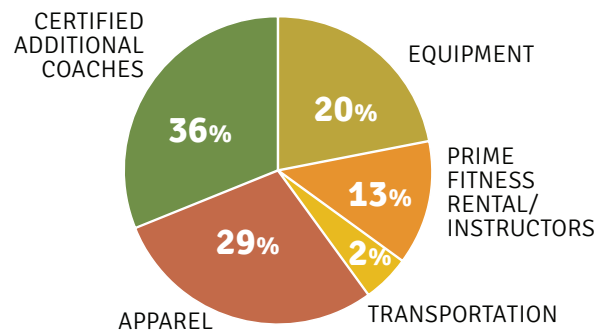
Please Note: Transportation to and from the Academy is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian.
