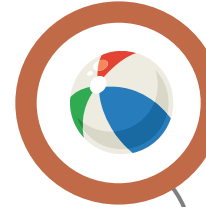
Attendees will hear from an industry expert about tips to help keep students safer, increase their privacy and protect their online digital footprint.

- **Tuesday, May 12** – 11am until 2pm at Qwam Qwum Stuwixwulh School, 1390 Stuywut Street, Nanaimo

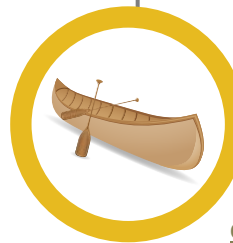
