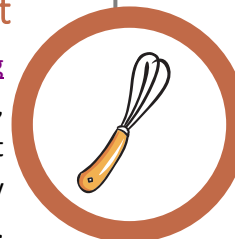

Board Report

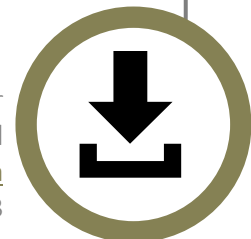
At the Education Committee Meeting on October 2, 2019, Deputy Superintendent Tim Davie shared information about school start up and classroom placement.
