

Printing From USB Memory Sticks

What's It Do?


You can print files directly from your USB memory stick. Compatible file types: PDF, XPS, JPG, TIFF, PPTX (Powerpoint), XLSX (Excel), and DOCX (Word).


- 1. Insert your USB stick into the port on the right side of your device.
- From the screen select *Print a* Document from External Memory
 (Note: this screen takes roughly 4 to 7 seconds to appear, depending on the device model).





- Select the file(s) you wish to print. For multiple files simply touch the names of all the files you need. You may also select a folder and press *Open* to search for your file in subfolders. Press *Print*.
- 4. IF desired, select the Print Settings needed from the Function buttons along the bottom of the screen, or select the *Application* button to show more options. (Eg: double sided output, paper tray, colour/black& white printing, stapling & hole punching if the optional finishing accessories are installed.)
- 5. Select the number of copies needed.
- Press the **Start** button to begin printing. DO NOT remove the USB stick while the device is retrieving the file from the USB stick (blue circle spinning on the screen).
- When finished scanning simply remove the USB stick. There is no Eject button.







Tips & Tricks

- When printing multiple files at once the device will use the default settings to print all your jobs. To select different settings for each file print only one at a time.
- If the panel has reset after your job and you wish to perform another task, press the icon circled (next to the *) to display the white USB option screen (step 2). Proceed with the next task. For scanning to the USB, see the cheat sheet titled USB Scanning KM e Series.
