

WIFI TROUBLESHOOTING

HELPING YOU SOLVE ISSUES WITH CONNECTING TO THE “BYOD” NETWORK

COMMON ISSUES

TRY THESE FIRST

- ➡ HAS YOUR PASSWORD BEEN **RESET** RECENTLY? IF SO, YOU MUST “FORGET” THE NETWORK, RE-CONNECT, AND ENTER YOUR USERNAME AND NEW PASSWORD
- ➡ MAKE SURE YOU ARE USING THE CORRECT “**BYOD**” NETWORK (STUDENT)
- ➡ IF YOU ARE STUCK ON THE WRONG NETWORK (I.E. SD68GUEST), YOU MUST “**FORGET**” THAT NETWORK BEFORE JOINING THE BYOD NETWORK
- ➡ SOMETIMES YOU MUST “**FORGET**” THE BYOD NETWORK AND ASK TO JOIN AGAIN
- ➡ IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO INPUT A **DOMAIN**, USE **SD68.BC.CA**

GENERAL TIPS

THESE CAN HELP WITH MULTIPLE ISSUES

- ➡ TURN YOUR DEVICE COMPLETELY OFF (**POWER OFF**) THEN RESTART
- ➡ TRY USING ALL **LOWERCASE LETTERS** IN YOUR USERNAME
- ➡ BE CAREFUL WHEN ENTERING YOUR PASSWORD (PASSWORDS ARE **CASE-SENSITIVE**)
- ➡ DO NOT PUT “@SD68.BC.CA” OR “@EDU” OR “@LEARN68.CA” IN YOUR **USERNAME**
