Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools is proud to have 8 StrongStart Early Learning Centres. In alignment with NLPS Strategic Plan Goal #2, our schools with StrongStart Centres seek to create welcoming and inclusive environments for families across the district. This goal is achieved through the following:

- StrongStart families are part of the school community, just like K to 7 families are. In fact, schools that have StrongStart Centres, are considered StrongStart to 7 rather than K to 7 schools.
- StrongStart Centres are ideally located in the heart of the school near the Kindergarten classrooms so that connections can be easily made.
- StrongStart families have access to the library and are welcome to sign out materials. In addition to the regular library items, StrongStarts-7 libraries offer a wonderful "Toy Lending Library" with a variety of playthings that support creative, dramatic, and energetic play.
- StrongStart families are welcome at school events such as concerts and fairs.
- StrongStart Centres have regularly scheduled gym times where preschoolers have the opportunity to run, jump, and play with their caregivers.
- StrongStart Principals connect with StrongStart families through frequently scheduled visits to the Centres
- StrongStart Centres welcome families on most school days and are closed when schools are closed.
