# TYPES OF BULLYING

OLOSER

Bullying is intentional and repeated behaviour that makes others feel uncomfortable, scared, or hurt. Bullying can take a number of different forms.

## Cyber

OUgly Harassment (teasing and humiliation) via digital devices including social media, text messages, video games, chat rooms, instant messaging, video games.

Online posting or distribution of intimate pictures / embarrassing images or videos, real or altered without the consent of the person in the image.

## Homophobia

Poor Treatment of or violence against people because of their' sexual orientation and/or gender identity.

Mean-Spirited name calling about a person's sexual orientation or gender.

Unwanted disclosure of a persons sexual or gender identity.

Purposeful mis'-prounounging and use of dead-naming.
